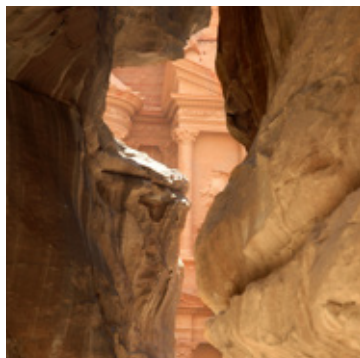
Dinner at the Dead Sea Panorama

Visit Madaba – the city of Mosaics which has the oldest known mosaic map of the Holy Land. There is a magnificent panoramic view over the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley to the hills on the other side of the rift, with the towers of Jerusalem visible on the skyline.

Jerash

One of the best-preserved provincial Roman towns in the world, Jerash lies about 45 km north of Amman, in a fertile valley with a perennial stream.

Mujib Canyoning

Experience Jordan's most famous river canyon. With a 1,300m variation in elevation and year round water flow from seven tributaries, Wadi Mujib enjoys a magnificent biodiversity that is still being explored and documented today.

In ancient times merchants travelled to Petra in caravans on their way to Gaza and Syria on the spice route.*
